BY-LAWS MISSIONARY BOARD

ARTICLE I – MEETINGS

- **SECTION 1**. The Committee shall meet the <u>first Saturday of every quarter</u> at 10:00 a.m.
- **SECTION 2.** Special meetings may be called by the president or, in the president's absence, by the vice president providing members are given a **twenty-four (24) hour** notice stating the purpose of the meeting.

ARTICLE II – POWER OF OFFICERS

- **SECTION 1.** The president shall preside at all meetings of the Committee; sign orders of the treasurer; shall represent the Committee before the public either personally or through representative.
- **SECTION 2.** The vice president shall assist the president in the performance of above duties and preside in the absence of the president.
- **SECTION 3.** The secretary shall keep an accurate record of the proceedings of the meetings of the Committee and keep a complete membership roll. In addition, the correspondence secretary shall be responsible for all correspondents.
- **SECTION 4.** The treasurer shall collect all dues and receive all money belonging to the Committee: keep an accurate account of the receipts and expenditures; pay all bills approved by Committee and signed by president; keep the Committee and president informed of the financial condition of the Committee.
- **SECTION 5**. The assistant treasurer shall assist the treasurer in the performance of the above duties.
- **SECTION 6.** Chaplain shall conduct devotion at all meetings or may designate someone to do so.
- **SECTION 7.** The Good Samaritan chairperson shall be responsible for reporting to Committee the names of any member has lost a loved one; shall contact sick persons or have someone on sub-committee to do so.

ARTICLE III – ACCESION TO THE OFFICE OF PRESIDENT

- **SECTION 1.** Each office shall serve for a one **(1) year** term, at which time may be re-elected by a 2/3 vote of all members present. If approved by the pastor.
- **SECTION 2.** Elections shall be held during the first committee meeting at the beginning of each year.

ARTICLE IV – DUES DONATIONS

- **SECTION 1.** The Committee shall send flowers or an offering of <u>\$50.00</u> to any member of the **Missionary Society** who loses a member of the immediate family, namely; husband, wife, mother, father, sister, brother, or child.
- **SECTION 2**. The committee shall send a card to any member of the Committee who is confined to the home because of illness (*one week or more*)
- **SECTION 3.** The Committee shall send a card with a donation of <u>\$25.00</u> to any member who is hospitalized.
